labor is not in vain" (1 Cor.15. 42-44, 58). What insight does Paul offer us on this Easter morning?

The Empty Tomb and Death Linen

The beloved disciple (John) becomes the first to place his faith in the resurrection of Jesus. He does so based upon the evidence of an empty tomb and neatly folded death linen. Which is to say that it wasn't really the empty tomb the led John to faith; it was the trustworthiness of Jesus that led him to embrace resurrection faith. Why do you believe in the resurrection of Jesus? Or not believe?


Why Do You Weep?

Sermon Reflection Guide

John 20.1-18

Early on the first day of the week, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene came to the tomb and saw that the stone had been removed from the tomb. So she ran and went to Simon Peter and the other disciple, the one whom Jesus loved, and said to them, "They have taken the Lord out of the tomb, and we do not know where they have laid him." Then Peter and the other disciple set out and went toward the tomb. The two were running together, but the other disciple outran Peter and reached the tomb first. He bent down to look in and saw the linen wrappings lying there, but he did not go in. Then Simon Peter came, following him, and went into the tomb. He saw the linen wrappings lying there, and the cloth that had been on Jesus' head, not lying with the linen wrappings but rolled up in a place by itself. Then the other disciple, who reached the tomb first, also went in, and he saw and believed; for as yet they did not understand the scripture, that he must rise from the dead. Then the disciples returned to their homes. But Mary stood weeping outside the tomb. As she wept, she bent over to look into the tomb; and she saw two angels in white, sitting where the body of Jesus had been lying, one at the head and the other at the feet. They said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping?" She said to them, "They have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid him." When she had said this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing there,

but she did not know that it was Jesus. Jesus said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you looking for?" Supposing him to be the gardener, she said to him, "Sir, if you have carried him away, tell me where you have laid him, and I will take him away." Jesus said to her, "Mary!" She turned and said to him in Hebrew, "Rabbouni!" (which means Teacher). Jesus said to her, "Do not hold on to me, because I have not yet ascended to the Father. But go to my brothers and say to them, 'I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.'"

Mary Magdalene went and announced to the disciples, "I have seen the Lord"; and she told them that he had said these things to her.

Question for Everyone:

(1) I am Spock-like in my stoicism in that I never cry, not even during "It's a Wonderful Life." (10) My eyes well with tears all the time like I'm constantly in the show "This is Us." Where are you on this range?

Mary Magdalene

In John's Easter story Mary Magdalene is the real heroine of the first resurrection morning. N.T. Wright points out that "if someone in the first century had wanted to invent a story about people seeing Jesus (after his death), they wouldn't have dreamed of giving the (starring role) to a woman. Let alone Mary Magdalene." If you were to preach a sermon about Mary Magdalene's presence at the empty tomb, what kinds of things would you point out?
