The Second Sunday of Easter, 3 April 2016

Sermon Series *"It's Sunday, but Monday's Coming"*

Sermon One: *"Peace"*

John 20.19-23

When it was evening on that day, the first day of the week, and the doors of the house where the disciples had met were locked for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." After he said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." When he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained."

Question for Everyone:

(1) I am filled with anxiety and fear. Fret is my default mode. (10) I am filled with a sense of deep well-being. Peace is my default mode. Where are you on this "peace" spectrum?

It's Still Easter

"Here we are today, just one Sunday after Easter but it seems like a month ago. The Easter crowd is gone; the dust has settled and it's time to get back to our normal routines. Our forbearers would say, 'not so fast dear ones. What's the rush? Let's linger with the Easter story.'" What is the wisdom of lingering with the Easter story?

Celebrating and Planning

This is the time the church celebrates what Jesus achieved on Easter

morning and also plans for the implementation of that achievement.

"There is all the difference in the world between something being achieved and something being implemented . . . The composer achieves the writing of the music; the performers implement it. Jesus has accomplished the defeat of death and now his followers, empowered by his spirit must implement his new creation plan" (N.T. Wright). What is your part in God's new creation plan?

It's Sunday, but Monday's Coming

"I would, however, suggest another important sequence, not nearly as dramatic but it is one we all face. It's the sequence from Sunday to Monday. It's Sunday, but Monday's coming. It's Sunday, but Monday anxiety is still knocking at my door." What is the greatest source of anxiety in your life? Why?

Peace

"Jesus promised his disciples that he would give them his peace. He said, 'Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you' (14.27). This scene Jesus' his promised kept." Are you at peace? Are you living in peace? Are you experiencing a deep peace rooted in an abiding relationship with God?

Shalom

"Shalom is about human flourishing. Shalom is about a world ordered by the loving kindness of God. God's desire for God's children is that we flourish. The source of this flourishing is the deep peace wrought by an abiding relationship with our Creator. Peace is our birthright as children of God. Without this peace, we will not flourish, our community will not flourish, and our neighborhood will not be ushered into the reign of God." Do you believe that God desires that you flourish? What factors may be hindering this?
