and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, 19 to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor."

Reflection Questions:

- How does identity help us navigate temptation?
- How have you seen American churches lured by the temptation to control resources (bread), to gain coercive top-down political power (kingdoms of this world) and centralized religious power (Temple)?



Read Isaiah 43:1-7

But now thus says the Lord, he who created you, O Jacob, he who formed you, O Israel: Do not fear, for I have redeemed you;

o not tear, tor I have redeemed you; I have called you by name, you are mine.

2 When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you; when you walk through fire you shall not be burned, and the flame shall not consume you.
