because only God is to be worshipped. Perhaps their hesitation has more to do with their inability to follow Jesus. Perhaps the disciples understood that to worship Jesus appropriately was not only about the piety of bowing, it was about living a life that honors him, living the Jesus way. Why do you think some disciples hesitated to worship Jesus?

A Hard Question

Richard Rohr said that, "How you live your life is your real and final truth, not what ideas you believe." Christians are revealed by the confession of their lives not the confession of their mouths. In what ways does your life bear witness to the Holy Trinity? One of our Common Practices is "attending to relationships that promote growth." What might you do to live more intentionally into this "common" practice?





Sermon Reflection Guide

Deuteronomy 6.4-9

Hear, O Israel: The Lord is our God, the Lord alone. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might. Keep these words that I am commanding you today in your heart. Recite them to your children and talk about them when you are at home and when you are away, when you lie down and when you rise. Bind them as a sign on your hand, fix them as an emblem on your forehead, and write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

Matthew 28.16-20

Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some doubted. And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

Question for Everyone:

(1) Doubt is my constant companion in relationship to my faith. (10) My faith is never challenged by doubt as hard questions about God never concern me. Where are you on this range?

Trinity Sunday

On Trinity Sunday the church is called to remember that God is revealed to us as the great Three in One. We worship One God who is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Which is to say the Church worships a God whose very essence is beyond rational explanation. That is to say, if God had not revealed God's self to us as Three in One, we would not have created this God. Response?

Trinitarian Community

Trinity Sunday is the day that Christians are called to remember, in the words of Stanley Hauerwas that, "the church is but the name of a people who have been formed to worship the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit." What kind of community is the Triune God creating among us? What does it mean to be a people who bear the image of the Holy Trinity?

Church

One of the reasons we encourage all of our Table Life people to participate in Table groups, Vespers, Common Meals, The Neighborhood Table . . . is that being together around food and the Scriptures, praying for one another and with one another is the means toward an elusive goal. The goal is Christian community, a loving, compassionate, caring people who can legitimately claim "church" as their name. To bear the image of the Triune God is to take community very seriously. Where are you on this range: (1) My church is my faith family through which I have many deep and meaningful friendships that help me grow in my faith. (10) Church is the place I go to get fed?

Community is Hard

Why? Why is it hard to coax Christians to enjoy life together? Why is it hard to get folks to pray together, gather together, play together? Why do we resist opportunities to experience community?
