We tithe as the means through which our community enjoys fiscal health so as to minister generously.

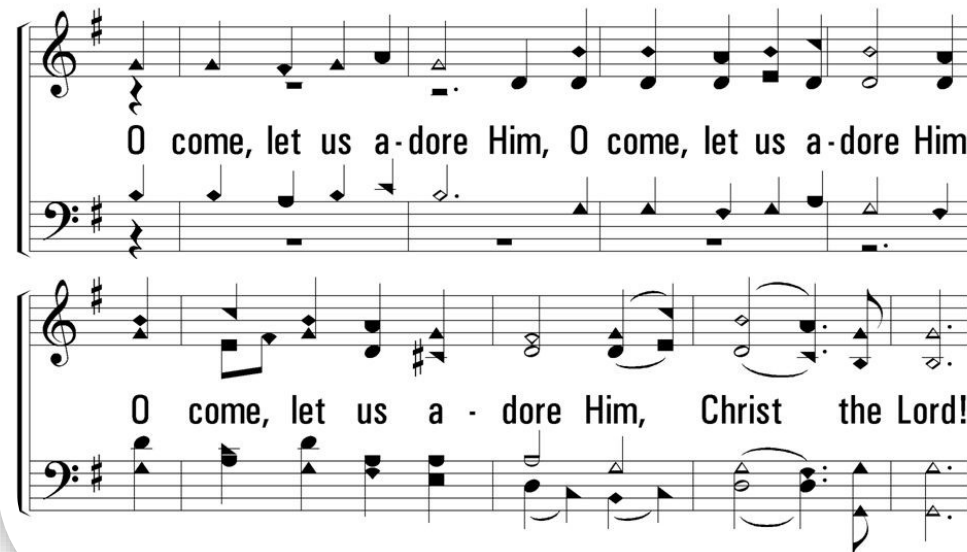
We Go
