had laid his hands on him. So the people of Israel obeyed him, doing just as the LORD had commanded Moses. ¹⁰ There has never been another prophet in Israel Israel like Moses, whom the LORD knew face to face. ¹¹ The LORD sent him to perform all the miraculous signs and wonders in the land of Egypt against Pharaoh, and all his servants, and his entire land. ¹² With mighty power, Moses performed terrifying acts in the sight of all Israel.
