So the people of Israel obeyed him, doing just as the LORD had commanded Moses. <sup>10</sup>There has never been another prophet in Israel like Moses, whom the LORD knew face to face. <sup>11</sup>The LORD sent him to perform all the miraculous signs and wonders in the land of Egypt against Pharaoh, and all his servants, and his entire land. <sup>12</sup>With mighty power, Moses performed terrifying acts in the sight of all Israel.

## Deuteronomy 31.1-8; 34.5-12 (NLT)

31 <sup>1</sup>When Moses had finished speaking all these words to all Israel, <sup>2</sup>he said to them: "I am now one hundred twenty years old. I am no longer able to get about, and the LORD has told me, 'You shall not cross over this Jordan.' <sup>3</sup>The LORD your God himself will cross over before you. He will destroy these nations before you, and you shall dispossess them. Joshua also will cross over before you, as the LORD promised. <sup>4</sup>The LORD will do to them as he did to Sihon and Og, the kings of the Amorites, and to their land, when he destroyed them. <sup>5</sup>The LORD will give them over to you and you shall deal with them in full accord with the command that I have given to you. <sup>6</sup>Be strong and bold; have no fear or dread of them, because it is the LORD your God who goes with you; he will not fail you or forsake you."

<sup>7</sup>Then Moses summoned Joshua and said to him in the sight of all Israel: "Be strong and bold, for you are the one who will go with this people into the land that the LORD has sworn to their ancestors to give them; and you will put them in possession of it. <sup>8</sup>It is the LORD who goes before you. He will be with you; he will not fail you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed."

34 <sup>5</sup>So Moses, the servant of the LORD, died there in the land of Moab, just as the LORD had said. <sup>6</sup>The LORD buried him in a valley near Beth-peor in Moab, but to this day no one knows the exact place. <sup>7</sup>Moses was 120 years old when he died, yet his eyesight was clear, and he was as strong as ever. <sup>8</sup>The people of Israel mourned for Moses on the plains of Moab for thirty days, until the customary period of mourning was over. <sup>9</sup>Now Joshua son of Nun was full of the spirit of wisdom, for Moses
