What makes the difference between someone stuck and someone who is resilient?

Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.

Joseph's Resiliency in Adversity:

Adversity	#1:		

Genesis 37:26-27 Judah said to his brothers, "What will we gain if we kill our brother and cover up his blood? ²⁷ Come, let's sell him to the Ishmaelites and not lay our hands on him; after all, he is our brother, our own flesh and blood." His brothers agreed.

Adversity #2:

Genesis 39:16-20 She kept his cloak beside her until his master came home. ¹⁷ Then she told him this story: "That Hebrew slave you brought us came to me to make sport of me. ¹⁸ But as soon as I screamed for help, he left his cloak beside me and ran out of the house." ¹⁹ When his master heard the story his wife told him, saying, "This is how your slave treated me," he burned

with anger. ²⁰ Joseph's master took him and put him in prison, the place where the king's prisoners were confined.

Adversity	#3:	
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Genesis 39:20-23 But while Joseph was there in the prison, ²¹ the Lord was with him; he showed him kindness and granted him favor in the eyes of the prison warden. ²² So the warden put Joseph in charge of all those held in the prison, and he was made responsible for all that was done there. ²³ The warden paid no attention to anything under Joseph's care, because the Lord was with Joseph and gave him success in whatever he did.

Adversity	#4 :		
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Genesis 40:23. The chief cupbearer, however, did not remember Joseph; he forgot him.

• "But the Lord was with him" – ___

Romans 5:3-5 Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; ⁴ perseverance, character; and character, hope. ⁵ And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us.
