## When God Doesn't Make Sense

### Part 1 - "Where Are You, God?"

#### Pastor Kris Beckert

#### Habakkuk's driving question:

*Hab 1:2-3 How long, Lord, must I call for help, but you do not listen? Or cry out to you, "Violence!" but you do not save? Why do you make me look at injustice? Why do you tolerate wrongdoing?*

#### I. The Book of Habakkuk:

- Habakkuk was one of the 12 \_\_\_\_\_
- Likely job as a \_\_\_\_\_
- Book written around \_\_\_\_\_ B.C.
- Name means "to \_\_\_\_\_" or "to \_\_\_\_\_"

*Hab 1:1 The prophecy that Habakkuk the prophet received.*

- "prophecy" : *massa'* (mas-saw')—
- Only one of the 12 Minor Prophets who \_\_\_\_\_

*Hab 1:2-4 How long, Lord, must I call for help, but you do not listen? Or cry out to you, "Violence!" but you do not save? <sup>3</sup> Why do*

you make me look at injustice? Why do you tolerate wrongdoing? Destruction and violence are before me; there is strife, and conflict abounds. <sup>4</sup> Therefore the law is paralyzed, and justice never prevails. The wicked hem in the righteous, so that justice is perverted.

## III. God's Response:

*Hab 1:5. "Look at the nations and watch and be utterly amazed. For I am going to do something in your days that you would not believe, even if you were told.*

- "utterly amazed": *tamahh* (taw-mah')—

*Hab 1:6-9 I am raising up the Babylonians, that ruthless and impetuous people, who sweep across the whole earth to seize dwellings not their own. <sup>7</sup> They are a feared and dreaded people; they are a law to themselves and promote their own honor. <sup>8</sup> Their horses are swifter than leopards,*

*fiercer than wolves at dusk. Their cavalry gallops headlong; their horsemen come from afar. They fly like an eagle swooping to devour; <sup>9</sup> they all come intent on violence...*

## It's possible to embrace simultaneous \_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_

*Hab 1:12-14 "Oh Lord, are not You from everlasting? My God, my Holy One, we will not die. You, Lord, have appointed them to execute judgment; you, my Rock, have ordained them to punish. <sup>13</sup> Your eyes are too pure to look on evil; you cannot tolerate wrongdoing. Why then do you tolerate the treacherous? Why are you silent while the wicked swallow up those more righteous than themselves? <sup>14</sup> You have made people like the fish in the sea, like the sea creatures that have no ruler.*
