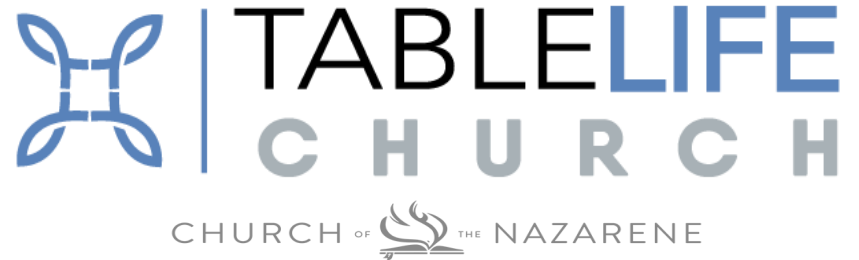

3. What does it look like to "be strong in the Lord?" What keeps you from relying on God's strength and showing up to do the work you need to do to get through discouragement? What is the "greater work" God could be doing in this time?
4. Do you often attempt to escape feeling discouraged? What difference does it make to know that discouragement is par for the course and you are not alone?
5. What have you started and maybe stopped or paused? How will you press on with God to be strong, show up, and do the work?

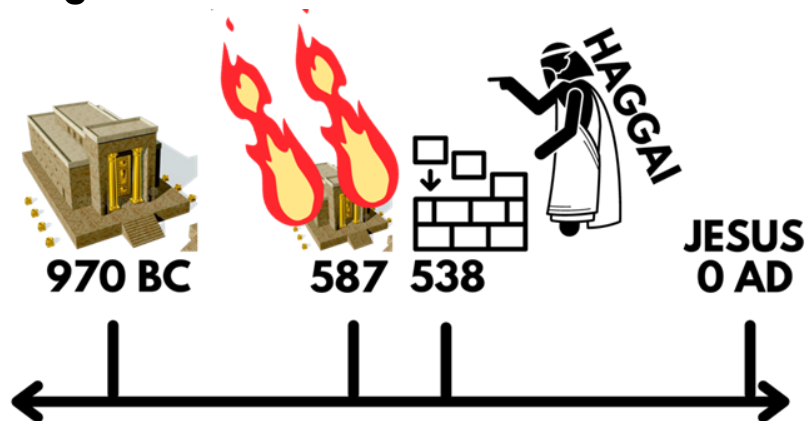

I. God often stirs up your _____ to _____

Haggai 1:13-15 Then Haggai, the Lord's messenger, gave this message of the Lord to the people: "I am with you," declares the Lord. ¹⁴ So the Lord stirred up the spirit of Zerubbabel son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and the spirit of Joshua son of Jozadak, the high priest, and the spirit of the whole remnant of the people. They came and began to work on the house of the Lord Almighty, their God, ¹⁵ on the twenty-fourth day of the sixth month.

II. Two causes of discouragement:

Haggai 2:1-3 on the twenty-first day of the seventh month, the word of the Lord came

through the prophet Haggai: ² “Speak to Zerubbabel son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, to Joshua son of Jozadak, the high priest, and to the remnant of the people. Ask them, ³ ‘Who of you is left who saw this house in its former glory? How does it look to you now? Does it not seem to you like nothing?’
