The Bible

Week #5: "Doesn't the Bible Say Women Shouldn't Preach?" Pastor Kris Beckert

I. Passages that seem to forbid female leadership:

Ephesians 5:22-24 Wives, submit yourselves to your own husbands as you do to the Lord. ²³ For the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church, his body, of which he is the Savior. ²⁴ Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit to their husbands in everything.

1 Timothy 2:11-12 A woman should learn in quietness and full submission. ¹² I do not permit a woman to teach or to assume authority over a man; she must be quiet.

1 Cor 14:34-35 Women should remain silent in the churches. They are not allowed to speak, but must be in submission, as the law says. ³⁵ If they want to inquire about something, they should ask their own husbands at home; for it is disgraceful for a woman to speak in the church.

Col 3:18 Wives, submit yourselves to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord.
