## Doggy Bag- Some questions to chew on:



1. In the past, what are some ways you have attempted to handle relationships with people who don't agree with you, believe differently than you, or are hostile to you? Would you give someone else the same instructions? Why or why not?
2. How does knowing the context of 1 Peter 3:1-7 help you better understand what Peter is saying? How is the action of a Christian wife or Christian husband toward an unbelieving spouse actually a subversive act of love?
3. Why are unity, compassion, love, sympathy, and humility important in our relationships within the Church?
4. When someone is hostile toward you, do you tend to fight, flight, or freeze? What would it look like for you to "seek peace and follow after it" the next time you encounter hostility?
5. What difference does it make for you to know that Jesus also experienced the complicated joy and pain of relationships? How is he calling you to be different in your response to others?

## Different "Part 4 - Different Relationships" Pastor Kris Beckert

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### When something requires assembly, do you...

### I. Peter's instructions for navigating three complicated relationships when you're following Jesus:

#### Relationship #1: With \_\_\_\_\_

*1 Peter 3:1-7 Wives, in the same way submit yourselves to your own husbands so that, if any of them do not believe the word, they may be won over without words by the behavior of their wives, <sup>2</sup> when they see the purity and reverence of your lives. <sup>3</sup> Your beauty should not come from outward adornment, such as elaborate hairstyles and the wearing of gold jewelry or fine clothes. <sup>4</sup> Rather, it should be that of your inner self, the unfading beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is of great worth in God's sight. <sup>5</sup> For this is the way the holy women of the past who put their hope in God used to adorn themselves. They submitted themselves to their own husbands, <sup>6</sup> like Sarah, who obeyed Abraham and called him her lord. You are her daughters if you do what is right*

and do not give way to fear. <sup>7</sup> Husbands, in the same way be considerate as you live with your wives, and treat them with respect as the weaker partner and as heirs with you of the gracious gift of life, so that nothing will hinder your prayers.

*1 Peter 3:8-9 Finally, all of you, be like-minded, be sympathetic, love one another, be compassionate and humble. <sup>9</sup> Do not repay evil with evil or insult with insult. On the contrary, repay evil with blessing, because to this you were called so that you may inherit a blessing.*

*1 Peter 3:10-14 For, "Whoever would love life and see good days must keep their tongue from evil and their lips from deceitful speech. <sup>11</sup> They must turn from evil and do good; they must seek peace and pursue it. <sup>12</sup> For the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous and his ears are attentive to their prayer, but the face of the Lord is against those who do evil." <sup>13</sup> Who is going to harm you if*

*you are eager to do good? <sup>14</sup> But even if you should suffer for what is right, you are blessed. "Do not fear their threats; do not be frightened."*

*1 Peter 3:15-18 But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect, <sup>16</sup> keeping a clear conscience, so that those who speak maliciously against your good behavior in Christ may be ashamed of their slander. <sup>17</sup> For it is better, if it is God's will, to suffer for doing good than for doing evil. <sup>18</sup> For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God. He was put to death in the body but made alive in the Spirit.*
