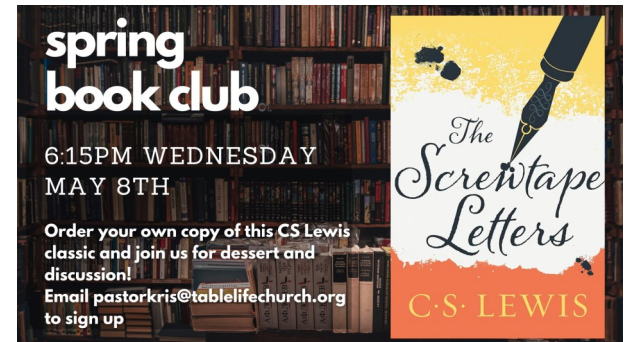
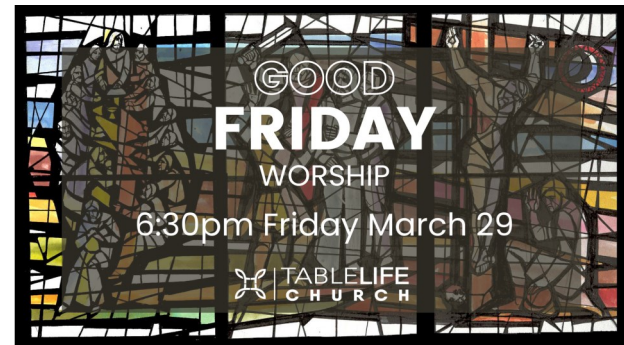

1. What of the four points about Jesus' Kingship, as depicted in his Triumphal Entry, resonates the most with you? What else would you add?
2. What does it mean that Jesus is in fact King, though not in the way people might expect or hope? How does this affect the way we live, work, and pray? How does this affect the way we read Scripture?
3. How does the fact that Jesus was predicted by the Scriptures centuries before his coming impact who you believe him to be? Is it strange to you that Jesus is never reported to have called himself "king?" Why or why not?
4. Has there ever been a time Jesus didn't deliver you from something but delivered you through something?
5. Why is it important to remember that the Kingdom of God comes in stages?
6. What is the difference between knowing who Jesus is and following him as your King? What does that look like?

Who is Jesus? "They Called Him King" Pastor Kris Beckert

What comes to mind when you hear the word "King?"

John 12:12-16 The next day the great crowd that had come for the festival heard that Jesus was on his way to Jerusalem. ¹³ They took palm branches and went out to meet him, shouting, "Hosanna!" "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" "Blessed is the king of Israel!" ¹⁴ Jesus found a young donkey and sat on it, as it is written: ¹⁵ "Do not be afraid, Daughter Zion; see, your king is coming, seated on a donkey's colt." ¹⁶ At first his disciples did not understand all this. Only after Jesus was glorified did they realize that these things had been written about him and that these things had been done to him."
