I. In 700 BC the Prophet Isaiah prophesies to Israel:

	are coming

•	is coming

Isaiah 35:1-10 The desert and the parched land will be glad; the wilderness will rejoice and blossom. Like the crocus, <sup>2</sup> it will burst into bloom; it will rejoice greatly and shout for joy. The glory of Lebanon will be given to it, the splendor of Carmel and Sharon; they will see the glory of the Lord, the splendor of our God.<sup>3</sup> Strengthen the feeble hands, steady the knees that give way; <sup>4</sup> say to those with fearful hearts, "Be strong, do not fear; your God will come, he will come with vengeance; with divine retribution he will come to save you." <sup>5</sup> Then will the eyes of the blind be opened and the ears of the deaf unstopped. <sup>6</sup> Then will the lame leap like a deer, and the mute tongue shout for joy. Water will gush forth in the wilderness and streams in the desert. <sup>7</sup> The burning sand will become a pool,

the thirsty ground bubbling springs. In the haunts where jackals once lay, grass and reeds and papyrus will grow. <sup>8</sup> And a highway will be there; it will be called the Way of Holiness; it will be for those who walk on that Way. The unclean will not journey on it; wicked fools will not go about on it. <sup>9</sup> No lion will be there, nor any ravenous beast; they will not be found there. But only the redeemed will walk there, <sup>10</sup> and those the Lord has rescued will return. They will enter Zion with singing; everlasting joy will crown their heads. Gladness and joy will overtake them, and sorrow and sighing will flee away.

# Keeping Our Eyes on the Road: An Advent Examination Question #1. " are you looking for?"

- Number of times joy/rejoice is mentioned: \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_
- Look for blooms in the desert:

Isaiah 35:1 The desert and the parched land will be glad; the wilderness will rejoice and blossom.

- Look for God's work in unlikely places, in unlikely ways, among unlikely people
- Jesus quotes Isaiah when John the Baptist asks if he is the Messiah:

Luke 7:22 "Go and tell John what you hear and see: the blind receive their sight, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear..."

Don't let expectations and assumptions blind you

Question #2. "\_\_\_\_\_ are you listening to?"

• What voices do you need to turn down or turn up?

Isaiah 35:3-4 Strengthen the feeble hands, steady the knees that give way; 4 say to those with fearful hearts, "Be strong, do not fear;

your God will come, he will come with vengeance; with divine retribution he will come to save you."

Question #3. "\_\_\_\_\_ are you headed?"

Isaiah 35:8-9 And a highway will be there; it will be called the Way of Holiness; it will be for those who walk on that Way. The unclean will not journey on it; wicked fools will not go about on it. 9 No lion will be there, nor any ravenous beast; they will not be found there. But only the redeemed will walk there...
