## Have you ever tried to move something that's immovable?

### The Greatest Story of Resurrection in the Bible: \_\_\_\_\_ and the \_\_\_\_\_

Mark 16:1-3 When the Sabbath was over, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices so that they might go to anoint Jesus' body. <sup>2</sup> Very early on the first day of the week, just after sunrise, they were on their way to the tomb <sup>3</sup> and they asked each other, "Who will roll the stone away from the entrance of the tomb?"

- I. The Big Problem: A\_\_\_\_\_ sealed the tomb
  - Ancient burial procedures included laying the body in a tomb and leaving it open so it could be prepared with \_\_\_\_\_

Mark 16:4-5 But when they looked up, they saw that the stone, which was very large, had been rolled away. <sup>5</sup> As they entered the tomb, they saw a young man dressed in a white robe sitting on the right side, and they were alarmed.

Mark 16: 6-7 "Don't be alarmed," he said. "You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid him. <sup>7</sup> But go, tell his disciples and Peter, 'He is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him, just as he told you.'"

- 3. Why is it important to remember that sometimes God rolls stones away overnight but other times it's over time?
- 4. The biggest "stone" Jesus rolled away was death. Because of Jesus' resurrection, we can know what will greet us on other side. Terror is removed from death. How does Jesus' resurrection impact how you live?
- 5. What is something that seems immovable in your life right now? What would it look like for you to take one step closer to Jesus and trust him with it? Where do you
