3. Why is it important to remember that sometimes God rolls stones away overnight but other times it's over time?
4. The biggest "stone" Jesus rolled away was death. Because of Jesus' resurrection, we can know what will greet us on other side. Terror is removed from death. How does Jesus' resurrection impact how you live?
