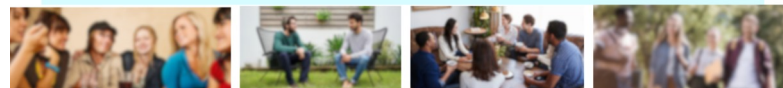

They said, "Why do you eat and drink with tax collectors and sinners?" ³¹ Jesus answered, "Healthy people don't need a doctor, but sick people do. ³² I didn't come to call righteous people but sinners to change their hearts and lives."

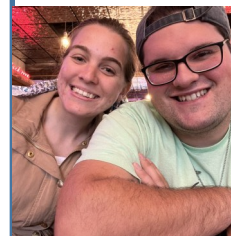
