

When it comes to the good news of Jesus, with whom are we supposed to share?

I. We are called to share with _____

John 3:16 God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him won't perish but will have eternal life.

Luke 5:29-32 Then Levi threw a great banquet for Jesus in his home. A large number of tax collectors and others sat down to eat with them. ³⁰ The Pharisees and their legal experts grumbled against his disciples. They said, "Why do you eat and drink with tax collectors and sinners?" ³¹ Jesus answered, "Healthy people don't need a doctor, but sick people do. ³² I didn't come to call righteous people but sinners to change their hearts and lives."

Luke 4, Isa 61:1-2 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because the Lord has anointed me. He has sent me to preach good news to the poor, to proclaim release to the prisoners and recovery of sight to the blind, to liberate the oppressed, ² and to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor.

Matthew 28:18-20 Jesus came near and spoke to them, "I've received all authority in heaven and on earth. ¹⁹ Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to obey everything that I've commanded you. Look, I myself will be with you every day until the end of this present age."
