### Worth Sharing "Part IV. How do I Share?" Pastor Kris Beckert

# Have you ever shared something because you had a wonderful experience?

John 1:35-46 The next day John was there again with two of his disciples. <sup>36</sup> When he saw Jesus passing by, he said, "Look, the Lamb of God!" 37 When the two disciples heard him say this, they followed Jesus. <sup>38</sup> Turning around, Jesus saw them following and asked, "What do you want?" They said, "Rabbi" (which means "Teacher"), "where are you staying?" <sup>39</sup> "Come," he replied, "and you will see." So they went and saw where he was staying, and they spent that day with him. It was about four in the afternoon. <sup>40</sup> Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, was one of the two who heard what John had said and who had followed Jesus. <sup>41</sup> The first thing Andrew did was to find his brother Simon and tell him, "We have found the Messiah" (that is, the Christ). <sup>42</sup> And he brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said. "You are Simon son of John. You will be called Cephas" (which, when translated, is Peter). <sup>43</sup> The next day Jesus decided to leave for Galilee. Finding Philip, he said to him, "Follow me." 44 Philip, like Andrew and Peter, was from the town of Bethsaida. <sup>45</sup> Philip found Nathanael and told him, "We have found the one Moses wrote about in the Law, and about whom the prophets also wroteJesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph." <sup>46</sup> "Nazareth! Can anything good come from there?" Nathanael asked. "Come and see," said Philip.

#### How do you share your faith without being weird?

1. Start where you \_\_\_\_\_, with the people you

- Jesus listened for the needs in people's lives and what they were looking for
- We can listen for the Not Cues: "things are not going well," "I'm not prepared for..." "I'm not from here," "That relationship was not healthy."
- 3. Risk \_\_\_\_\_
- The people in John 1 said: "Come and see"
  "Follow me" "Check out what I have found"

They don't judge or assume or tell, but rather
