1. What stood out to you most from this message?
2. What do you notice about the invitations given in John 1:35-36? Can you relate or have a similar experience to any of them?
3. When it comes to sharing your faith, why should you start where you are and with the people you know? What could that look like?
4. Why is it important to listen first, before sharing anything? What does a nudge from God feel like?
5. Has there ever been a time you “said someone else’s ‘no’ for them” and wonder what might have happened had you invited them?
6. Why is it necessary to let go of the outcome? How does considering a long-range view of someone’s faith story put your part in perspective?

Worth Sharing “Part IV. How do I Share?” Pastor Kris Beckert

Have you ever shared something because you had a wonderful experience?

John 1:35-46 The next day John was there again with two of his disciples. ³⁶ When he saw Jesus passing by, he said, “Look, the Lamb of God!” ³⁷ When the two disciples heard him say this, they followed Jesus. ³⁸ Turning around, Jesus saw them following and asked, “What do you want?” They said, “Rabbi” (which means “Teacher”), “where are you staying?” ³⁹ “Come,” he replied, “and you will see.” So they went and saw where he was staying, and they spent that day with him. It was about four in the afternoon. ⁴⁰ Andrew, Simon Peter’s brother, was one of the two who heard what John had said and who had followed Jesus. ⁴¹ The first thing Andrew did was to find his brother Simon and tell him, “We have found the Messiah” (that is, the Christ). ⁴² And he brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, “You are Simon son of John. You will be called Cephas” (which, when translated, is Peter). ⁴³ The next day Jesus decided to leave for Galilee. Finding Philip, he said to him, “Follow me.” ⁴⁴ Philip, like Andrew and Peter, was from the town of Bethsaida. ⁴⁵ Philip found Nathanael and told him, “We have found the one Moses wrote about in the Law, and about whom the prophets also wrote—
