A Question of Authority

Mark 1:21-28

Pastor Ken Mills

Who has the right opinion, or what authority matters today?

Mark 1:21-28 They went to Capernaum, and when the Sabbath came, Jesus went into the synagogue and began to teach. ²² The people were amazed at his teaching, because he taught them as one who had authority, not as the teachers of the law. ²³ Just then a man in their synagogue who was possessed by an impure spirit cried out, ²⁴ "What do you want with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are—the Holy One of God!" ²⁵ "Be quiet!" said Jesus sternly. "Come out of him!" ²⁶ The impure spirit shook the man violently and came out of him with a shriek. ²⁷ The people were all so amazed that they asked each other, "What is this? A new teaching—and with authority! He even gives orders to impure spirits and they obey him." ²⁸ News about him spread quickly over the whole region of Galilee.

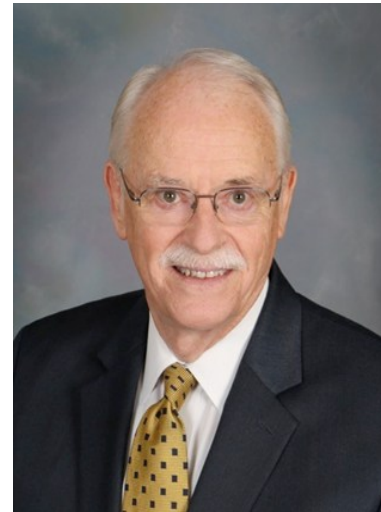

Big Idea:

Guest Speaker: Dr. Kenneth Mills

Kenneth Mills is a retired elder with the Church of the Nazarene. Pastor Ken was born in Western Pennsylvania (Rochester), grew up in Virginia (Richmond and Petersburg areas), and went to High School in Ashtabula, Ohio.



From Eastern Nazarene College, he graduated with a major in Psychology in 1966 and a minor in Biblical Literature. He graduated from Nazarene Theological Seminary in 1969 and was ordained as an Elder in the Church of the Nazarene in 1971. Later, he pursued a Doctor of Ministry degree while pastoring in Massachusetts, taking classes at Gordon Conwell Seminary, and graduating from Boston University in 1979. Prior to his last pastorate of five years in Shippensburg, PA., he served as district

superintendent of the Mid-Atlantic District for the Church of the Nazarene for nineteen years, having moved to the Mid-Atlantic District from the New England District, where he also served as a district superintendent for five years. Before being elected as district superintendent in New England, he pastored the Community Chapel Church of the Nazarene in Nashua, NH, and Peabody/Danvers, MA Church of the Nazarene, and had served as a youth pastor at Canton, Ohio, First Church of the Nazarene, and Nashville, TN, First Church of the Nazarene.

He is the husband of Patti (whom he met in college), and they have three children. Kenneth Jr. (the oldest child) is married to Kathy and has three children (Emylie, Aidan, and Jarrod) and one grandson. Kristen, their single daughter, lives in Woodstock, NY, and is an artist (in every sense of the word)! Their youngest daughter, Kerri, is married to Jared Lewis, and they are presently living in Cape Girardeau, MO. They have three children, Jayce, Bryanna, and Judah.
