Some questions to chew on:



- 1. Who is someone you would describe as joyful? What makes them joyful?
- 2. On a scale of 1-10, how would you rate your joy? Would the people who know you best describe you as joyful?
- 3. Why do you think joy was a mark of the coming messiah? Why do you think "remaining in Jesus" is the key to bearing fruit of the Spirit, including joy?
- 4. In John 15:8–12. Jesus connects joy to obedience, which is not the first thing most of us think about when we think about joy. How do you think obedience leads to joy?
- 5. After explaining the connection between obeying his commands, remaining in him, and our joy being complete, Jesus says: "Love each other as I have loved you." Why must loving others be part of lasting joy?
- 6. When was a time when you were in the middle of unmet expectations or difficulty but still had joy? What happened, and what did you learn about God as a result?
- 7. How have you seen the effects of joy (envy to contentment, greed to generosity, etc) play out in real life? Share an example.
- 8. Why does the world teach a Y-O-J approach to joy? This Advent, how can you be intentional about cultivating a J-O-Y kind of joy?
