- 1. Do you have a family situation that makes
  Christmas difficult? To what extent is Christmas
  a reminder that there are problems you can't solve, people you
  can't control, and expectations you can't meet?
- 2. When was the last time you leaned in toward a difficult person instead of keeping your distance? What happened?
- 3. When was a time you experienced Jesus' love for you? Have you fully accepted his love as a gift? How easy or difficult is it for you to accept his love?
- 4. What does John show you about who Jesus loves? What does that mean for others? For you? For your interactions with others?
- 5. Do you tend to lean more toward grace or more toward truth? Why is it so important that Jesus never dumbed down the truth and never dialed back the grace?
- 6. The difficulty of loving others often becomes more apparent at Christmastime but is an opportunity for us to follow the example of Jesus by drawing near anyway. What would it look like for you to follow Jesus in this area and take a step and show love toward someone in your life that you might shy away from because it's not easy or comfortable?
