1. Is there a certain food that takes you back? In what way have memories of certain meals been meaningful and holy for you?
2. What stands out to you about the story of the Last Supper, as told by the Gospel of Mark? What is significant about Jesus beginning his final 24 hours with this meal?
3. How would you describe the atmosphere surrounding Jesus' Passover meal? Why? What aspects probably surprised the disciples?
4. What things did Jesus want to help the disciples remember as he celebrated the Last Supper with them? What was new about what he did and why?
5. What things does our celebration of the Lord's Supper help us remember? How have you experienced Jesus in the Lord's Supper?
6. Does a certain experience of the Lord's Supper stand out in your memory? Why?
7. As we start the Lenten season, what does God need you to remember?

Twenty-Four Hours Week #1. The Last Supper Pastor Kris Beckert

I. The Last 24 Hours of Jesus' Life:

- Jesus was crucified at age _____, having lived 12,000 days
- The Gospels write mostly about the last 1,100 days of Jesus' life
- The largest portion of the Gospels tells of Jesus' last 24 hours
- What happened at the end of Jesus' life changed the world

II. The beginning of the end: The _____

Mark 14:12-16 On the first day of the Festival of Unleavened Bread, when it was customary to sacrifice the Passover lamb, Jesus' disciples asked him, "Where do you want us to go and make preparations for you to eat the Passover?"¹³ So he sent two of his disciples, telling them, "Go into the city, and a man carrying a jar of water will meet you. Follow him.¹⁴ Say to the owner of the house he enters, 'The Teacher asks: Where is my guest room, where I may eat the Passover with my disciples?'¹⁵ He will show you a large room upstairs, furnished and ready. Make preparations for us there."¹⁶ The disciples left, went into the city and found things just as Jesus had told them. So they prepared the Passover.

2. What Happens at the Supper:

#1. We remember _____

Mark 14:18-21 While they were reclining at the table eating, he said, "Truly I tell you, one of you will betray me—one who is eating with me." 19 They were saddened, and one by one they said to him, "Surely you don't mean me?" 20 "It is one of the Twelve," he replied, "one who dips bread into the bowl with me. 21 The Son of Man will go just as it is written about him. But woe to that man who betrays the Son of Man! It would be better for him if he had not been born."

#2. We remember _____

Mark 14:22-26 While they were eating, Jesus took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take it; this is my body." 23 Then he took a cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, and they all drank from it. 24 "This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many," he said to them. 25 "Truly I tell you, I will not drink again from the fruit of the vine until that day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God." 26 When they had sung a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives.
