### Some questions to chew on:



1. On a scale of 1-10, how tolerant are you of pain? When was a time you were willing to endure pain because it had a purpose?
2. What difference does it make to know that Jesus not only sees but participates in our pain?
3. It is stated that God usually doesn't cause our pain, but he can use it. How does that change your perspective of pain? Why is it important to recognize God did not make people abuse Jesus but rather God used his suffering?
4. What stands out to you about what Jesus endured? In your own words, why did Jesus suffer? What purpose did it serve?
5. What does Simon of Cyrene teach us? Can you relate to him? In your own life, how has God provided "partners in pain?"
6. What pain can help you to draw closer to Christ and have compassion for others? What is God showing you in this part of the story of Jesus' last 24 hours?

## Twenty-Four Hours Week #5. The Suffering Servant Pastor Kris Beckert

### I. The Last 24 Hours of Jesus' Life:

- Jesus and the disciples celebrated \_\_\_\_\_ in the Upper Room

*Mark 15:15-23* Wanting to satisfy the crowd, Pilate released Barabbas to them. He had Jesus flogged, and handed him over to be crucified. <sup>16</sup> The soldiers led Jesus away into the palace (that is, the Praetorium) and called together the whole company of soldiers. <sup>17</sup> They put a purple robe on him, then twisted together a crown of thorns and set it on him. <sup>18</sup> And they began to call out to him, "Hail, king of the Jews!" <sup>19</sup> Again and again they struck him on the head with a staff and spit on him. Falling on their knees, they paid homage to him. <sup>20</sup> And when they had mocked him, they took off the purple robe and put his own clothes on him. Then they led him out to crucify him. <sup>21</sup> A certain man from Cyrene, Simon, the father of Alexander and Rufus, was passing by on his way in from the country, and they forced him to carry the cross. <sup>22</sup> They brought Jesus to the place called Golgotha (which means "the place of the skull"). <sup>23</sup> Then they offered him wine mixed with myrrh, but he did not take it.

## A Few Differences Between Gospel Accounts:

- Luke says Pilate sent Jesus to \_\_\_\_\_

*Isaiah 50:6 I offered my back to those who beat me, my cheeks to those who pulled out my beard; I did not hide my face from mocking and spitting.*
