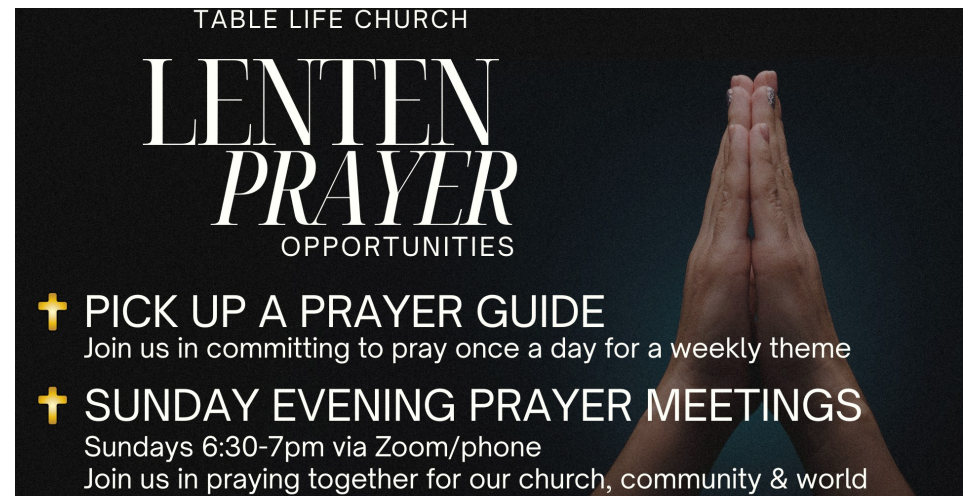

### Some questions to chew on:



1. Has fear ever led you to do or not do something you now regret? Why? What happened? Why is fear so powerful?
2. Whose fear can you most relate to in the story of Jesus' arrest and why? What stands out to you?
3. Like the disciples, have you ever decided to leave Jesus/faitn/church because things were too difficult, painful, or problematic? Why would fear lead someone to lie or cheat?
4. Has your relationship with God ever been characterized by fear? How did that affect you?
5. What about Jesus caused the greatest fear for Caiphias? Can you relate?
6. Peter denied Jesus because he was afraid of the cost. Has it cost you anything to follow Jesus? What sacrifices have you had to make? What is the cost of discipleship?
7. How does fear lead us both individually and collectively? How does fear lead us to justify actions that otherwise would be unthinkable?
8. What is God teaching you so far about the last 24 hours of Jesus' life?

## Twenty-Four Hours Week #3. The Arrest Pastor Kris Beckert

#### I. The Last 24 Hours of Jesus' Life:

- Jesus and the disciples celebrated \_\_\_\_\_ in the Upper Room

Mark 14:47-50 Then one of those standing near drew his sword and struck the servant of the high priest, cutting off his ear. <sup>48</sup> "Am I leading a rebellion," said Jesus, "that you have come out with swords and clubs to capture me? <sup>49</sup> Every day I was with you, teaching in the temple courts, and you did not arrest me. But the Scriptures must be fulfilled." <sup>50</sup> Then everyone deserted him and fled.

**2. \_\_\_\_\_ was afraid**

- Consisted of 71 elders, the wisest and most holy men (Numbers 11:16)
- Ruled over religious affairs and courts
- Always met during the \_\_\_\_\_, in a \_\_\_\_\_ place, never on \_\_\_\_\_

*Mark 14:55-59 The chief priests and the whole Sanhedrin were looking for evidence against Jesus so that they could put him to death, but they did not find any. <sup>56</sup> Many testified falsely against him, but their statements did not agree. <sup>57</sup> Then some stood up and gave this false testimony against him: <sup>58</sup> “We heard him say, ‘I will destroy this temple made with human hands and in three days will build another, not made with hands.’” <sup>59</sup> Yet even then their testimony did not agree.*

**3. \_\_\_\_\_ was afraid**

*Mark 14:60-65 Then the high priest stood up before them and asked Jesus, “Are you not going to answer? What is this testimony that these men are bringing against you?” <sup>61</sup> But Jesus remained silent and gave no answer. Again the high priest asked him, “Are you the Messiah, the Son of the Blessed One?” <sup>62</sup> “I am,” said Jesus. “And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Mighty One and coming on the clouds of heaven.” <sup>63</sup> The high priest tore his clothes. “Why do we need any more witnesses?” he asked. <sup>64</sup> “You have heard the blasphemy. What do you think?” They all condemned him as worthy of death. <sup>65</sup> Then some began to spit at him; they blindfolded him, struck him with their fists, and said, “Prophecy!” And the guards took him and beat him.*

**4. \_\_\_\_\_ was afraid**

*Mark 14:70-72 After a little while, those standing near said to Peter, “Surely you are one of them, for you are a Galilean.” <sup>71</sup> He began to call down curses, and he swore to them, “I don’t know this man you’re talking about.” <sup>72</sup> Immediately the rooster crowed the second time. Then Peter remembered the word Jesus had spoken to him: “Before the rooster crows twice you will disown me three times.” And he broke down and wept.*
