## A Good Question: Is hope worth it?

*Romans 8:24-25 For in this hope we were saved. But hope that is seen is no hope at all. Who hopes for what they already have? <sup>25</sup> But if we hope for what we do not yet have, we wait for it patiently.*

## What the Easter story teaches us about hope:

#1. Hope \_\_\_\_\_

*Mark 16:1-3 When the Sabbath was over, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices so that they might go to anoint Jesus' body. <sup>2</sup> Very early on the first day of the week, just after sunrise, they were on their way to the tomb <sup>3</sup> and they asked each other, "Who will roll the stone away from the entrance of the tomb?"*

Mark 16:4-8 *But when they looked up, they saw that the stone, which was very large, had been rolled away. <sup>5</sup> As they entered the tomb, they saw a young man dressed in a white robe sitting on the right side, and they were alarmed. <sup>6</sup> "Don't be alarmed," he said. "You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid him. <sup>7</sup> But go, tell his disciples and Peter, 'He is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him, just as he told you.'"* <sup>8</sup> Trembling and bewildered, the women went out and fled from the tomb. They said nothing to anyone, because they were afraid.

#### Some questions to chew on:

1. Has there ever been a time you waited for something that never happened? What did it feel like? How did that affect your hope?
2. Looking at the Easter story, why is it important to remember that hope starts in the dark and at a tomb? Has there ever been a time God was at work but you just couldn't see it yet?
3. What made the women so afraid when they visited the tomb? Why do we need to recognize that hope often takes time and cannot be forced?
4. Why are there two different endings to the Easter Story in Mark's Gospel? In which ending do you find yourself?
5. In what ways has hope delivered in your life? What evidence have you seen? In what ways are you still waiting?
6. In your own words, why is hope worth it? This Easter, will you let God heal your hope?
