Philippians 1:20 – 24 ISV alt.

"I rejoice because I eagerly expect and hope that I will have nothing to be ashamed of, because through my boldness Christ will be exalted through me, now as always, whether I live or die.

²¹ For to me, to go on living is Christ, and to die is gain. ²² Now if I continue living, fruitful labor is the result, so I do not know which I would prefer. ²³ Indeed, I cannot decide between the two. I have the desire to leave and be with Christ, for that is far better. ²⁴ But for your sake it is better that I remain alive"

Philippians 3:8 – 11 CEB

I consider everything a loss in comparison with the superior value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. I have lost everything for him, but what I lost I think of as sewer trash, so that I might gain Christ ⁹ and be found in him. In Christ I have a status that is not my own and that does not come from Legalism but rather from the faithfulness of Christ: the status from God that is based on faith. ¹⁰ The good standing that I have comes from knowing Christ, the power of his resurrection, and the participation in his sufferings. It includes being conformed to his death ¹¹ so that I may somehow reach the goal of the resurrection of the dead.
